The International Angel Association has 50 educational institutions all over the country. In addition many women graduates at their women welfare centre work on embroidered Nakshi Kantha goods that are sold in the international as well as in the local market.

Since Bangladesh's independence, Japan has continuously been supporting Bangladesh, especially in the field of economic and social development. Major areas of our assistance are, 1. Disaster relief, Japan also gives assistance directly to some NGOs under the Grant-Assistance for Grass-roots Human secrutity projects (GGHSP) which started in 1989. Activities

1. Shishu Sadan (Orphanage): 145 Children included this program since 1986. This year 60 children accommodated in Shishu Sadan. The organisation will go on guiding their with proper care until they become self-reliant and acquire the ability of maintain their livelihood.

2. Student Help Programme : Human Resource Development is important for our populated country. Education is the backbone of nation.



Keeping this in mind, the Organisation provide scholarship to poor & meritorious students from class six to university level. A number of 4,500 students are receiving the opportunity to continue their study this year.

3. Health Care Centre: Health Care Centre is an out door clinic. Serving the local people with minimum fees. Regular doctors consultancy for general patients (Gynaecologist, Child specialist) and weekly one day Eyes facilities. Pathological test, X-ray, Ultrasound and others facilities are given to the people by subsidies rate. Yearly Eye Camp arrange every year in the month of December. Under this programme patients are given free treatment, Medicine and Cataract Operation. A number of 578



patients are successfully setup Lens their eyes. In the prevention of childhood blindness this Organisation distribute Vitamin A capsule among the rural school children.

4. Agriculture Training Centre: Agriculture training Centre provides training in Agriculture, Poultry, Dairy and fisheries to the rural women since 1994. This training requires a minimum of secondary school graduation and training is designed for six month especially for women. 60 trainees divided by two session (Jan-June & July-Dec) selected all over the country. The Organisation gives free hostel accommodation and food for all trainees. A number of 629 trainees completed the course and



working at GOs, NGOs, private farm as well as in their own Agriculture fields. Also especial short training on poultry provided to 2000 rural people at Gazipur district.

5. Technical Training Centre: Technical Training Centre provides training to women on Tailoring, Nakshi Kantha, Embroidery, Type writing & Computer since 1993. The Organisation gives free hostel accommodation &

food for trainees. A number of 3,590 trainees successfully completed the courses so far. Training enhances skill and increases prospects for competent jobs.





6. Cultural Centre (Library) : A large number of students and local people get this opportunities to read books. A number of 8000 books are available in this library. Every year the Cultural Centre arranges cultural program and



speech contest on the day of the International Mother Language day, the Independence day, the Hiroshima day, the Victory day, the Birth Anniversary of Rabindranath, Nazrul Islam, Jashim Uddin, Abbas Uddin and Joynul Abedin. The students of different school & college participate this Speech contest and Cultural program. There are 5 Community Library for the rural people at Kapasia under Gazipur district also.

7. Women Welfare Centre: Women Welfare Centre creates job opportunities in tailoring and handicraft ex-trainees, through its production



centre. A number of Women are regular working in Konabari centre. 300 women are working in others 2 sub centres at Kapashia upazila under Gazipur district.

8. Yuriko Angel School : The children of today will lead the nation tomorrow. But if their education is not complete, they would not be able to lead the country for peace and prosperity. Keeping this in mind, the Organisation started Yuriko Angel School from January 2005.



9. School Construction : The Organisation has built 49 school building to provide better facilities for the students.
